


21 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2025):

1. Close Johnny Grant Way from Orange Drive to Orchid Ave from 8:00 AM to 8:00 AM Saturday, March 8, 2025, except for emergency vehicles.






14 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 16, 2025):

1. Close north curb lane of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to south east corner of Orange Drive from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM Wednesday, March 5, 2025. (Except MTA buses until Thursday, February 20, 2025).

2. Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 230 feet east of Orange Drive allowing 8-foot pedestrian access from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 5, 2025.

3. Close east and west curb lanes on Orange Drive from Hollywood Boulevard to Johnny Grant Way from 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM Tuesday, March 4, 2025.






11 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 19, 2025):

1. Close north curb lane of Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 5, 2025. MTA to re-route bus traffic.

2. Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard in front of the Dolby Theatre portal from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 5, 2025. This is a complete sidewalk closure in front of the entrance to Awards Walk. Pedestrian traffic re-routed and emergency access available.






10 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 20, 2025):

1. Close all lanes of Hollywood Boulevard (with 20-ft Fire Lane) from the southeast corner of Orange Drive to Highland Avenue from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 5, 2025.

2. Close the pedestrian crosswalk, mid-block on Hollywood Boulevard between Orange Drive and Highland Avenue, from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 5, 2025.

3. Close south sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Orange Drive to Highland Avenue from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 5, 2025, except 8-foot pedestrian access.

4. Close balance of north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive allowing 8-foot pedestrian access from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 5, 2025.






7 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 23, 2025):

1. Close south curb lane of Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 5, 2025. MTA to re-route bus traffic.

2. Close Hawthorn Alley behind El Capitan Theatre from 300 feet east of Orange Drive east to the "T" alley from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 5, 2025. The remainder of Hawthorn Alley to remain open from the "T" east to Highland Avenue.






6 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (MONDAY, FEBRUARY 24, 2025):

1. Close Hawthorn Alley on the east side of the El Capitan Theatre from Hollywood Boulevard south 210 feet


to "T" of east/west alley from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Wednesday, March 5, 2025.





2 DAYS PRIOR TO SHOW (FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 28, 2025):

1. Close Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 3, 2025.





1 DAY PRIOR TO SHOW (SATURDAY, MARCH 1, 2025):

1. Close Orchid Avenue from 60 feet south of Franklin Boulevard to Johnny Grant Way from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 3, 2025 except for residents, emergency vehicles, and hotel loading.


2. Close Orange Drive from Johnny Grant Way to Hollywood Boulevard from 6:00 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 3, 2025. Except for local residents, local business access, and emergency vehicles.

3. Close north and south sidewalk of Hawthorn Avenue from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 12:01 AM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 3, 2025.

4. Close north sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 3, 2025. MTA station to be by-passed from the last regularly scheduled train on Saturday, March 1 until the first scheduled train ther 6:00 AM Monday, March 3, 2025. Pedestrian traffic rerouted to south sidewalk.

5. Close west sidewalk of Highland Avenue from Johnny Grant Way south to Hollywood Boulevard from 10:00 PM to 9:00 AM Monday, March 3, 2025.

6. Close Johnny Grant Way from Highland Avenue to Orange Drive from 10:00 PM to 6:00 AM Monday, March 3, 2025.





DAY OF SHOW (SUNDAY, MARCH 2 - MONDAY, MARCH 3, 2025):

12:01 am March 2 – 6 am March 3, close:

- 1. Remainder of Hawthorn Alley from Orange Drive to Highland Avenue.
- 2. Orange Drive from Hollywood Boulevard to Lanewood Avenue.
- 3. North sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 300 feet east of Highland Avenue. No pedestrian access.
- 4. South sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to 300 feet east of Highland Avenue, 8-foot pedestrian access.

5. South sidewalk of Hollywood Boulevard directly in front of the north-south Hawthorn Alley. No pedestrian access to cross alley.

- 6. East sidewalk and curb lane of Highland Avenue from Yucca Street to Sunset Blvd. 8-foot pedestrian access (300 ft. south of Hollywood Blvd only).
- 7. Extend closure of west sidewalk of Highland Avenue from Hollywood Blvd to Sunset Blvd.
- 8. West curb of Highland Avenue from Johnny Grant Way to Hollywood Blvd UNTIL 9:00 AM

From 4am March 2 – 4am March 3, close:

- 9. North and south crosswalks on Hollywood Boulevard at the Highland Avenue intersection.
- 10. Highland Avenue from Sunset Boulevard to Franklin Avenue.
- 11. Hollywood Boulevard from La Brea Ave to Orange Drive.
- 12. Hollywood Boulevard from Highland Avenue to Cahuenga Boulevard.

Except for local residents, business access and emergency vehicles, close the following between 4am March 2 – 4am March 3:

- 13. Hawthorn Avenue between Orange Drive and La Brea Ave.
- 14. Hawthorn Avenue between Highland Avenue and McCadden Place.
- 15. McCadden Place between Yucca Street and Hollywood Boulevard.
- 16. Yucca Street between Highland Avenue and Wilcox Avenue.
- 17. Wilcox Avenue between Sunset Blvd and Cahuenga Boulevard.
- 18. South sidewalk of Franklin Ave from Orchid Ave to Highland Ave.
- 19. Hillcrest Road s/o Franklin Ave to dead end.

Restrict access on streets that end at or intersect Hollywood Boulevard and Highland Avenue at the discretion of the LAPD and LADOT.
